



## THE CRAPE MYRTLE TRAILS OF MCKINNEY PRESENTS THE BEST OF "THE TRAILS"

Eldorado Parkway is one of the most impressive stretches of planted medians along The Crape Myrtle Trails of McKinney. You will see major plantings between Ridge Road to the west and McDonald Street east of Central Expressway. Other major plantings have been made in medians of other streets as well.

While you are in McKinney, we hope that you will take the time to drive The Trails and take in the wide range of colors this plant has to offer. Here are sequential lists of the varieties

planted along Eldorado Parkway and other divided roadways within The Trails. The varieties are listed area by area, in general planting order of the flower colors you will be seeing as you drive The Trails.

(Please note that for Eldorado Parkway, we are giving you the planting sequences for eastbound driving, followed by the reversed planting sequences should you choose to drive westbound instead.)

### ELDORADO PARKWAY (WEST TO EAST)

If you are traveling from west-to-east (better vista for afternoon and evening), the following is your sequence of plantings beginning at Ridge Road in West McKinney.
